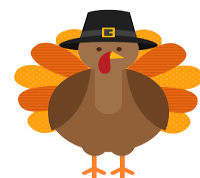

APPROPRIATE CLOTHING: Although our temperatures are not reflecting it, we have entered the fall season. Please make sure that when the temperatures start to change that you have clothing at school for your child that is appropriate for the weather. It is a SC Department of Social Service Child Care Licensing Regulation 114-506 (8) that "All children shall be given the opportunity for outdoor play daily, weather permitting." We will not go outside in the rain or when temperatures are outside of the recommended ranges according the Child Care Weather Watch.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AFTER A FEVER: Keep your child home for a fever of 101 degrees or higher by mouth or 100 degrees or higher if taken under the arm. Your child can return to school or childcare with a parent note when the fever is gone for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications. Please note: An infant 4 months of age or younger with a fever (100.4 F) should receive medical attention.
