KIDREPORTS: Parents/guardians, the director and teachers cannot express to you the importance of completing your KidReports daily. This program gives vital information that your child's teacher needs to be able to adequately care and educate your child during the day.



Completing the drop-off note **IS NOT** an option, it is a requirement. Daily reports should be completed within 1 hour of dropping off your child. The app is available in the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store. If you need assistance in downloading the app to your smart phone, please see your child's teacher or the director. If you do not have a smart phone, you can access the program on a desktop computer OR you can complete the daily report upon check-in (please see your child's teacher for this option).

DROP-OFF TIME: Unless you have informed the director via KidReports AND present with a doctor's note at drop-off, all students must be present **NO LATER THAN 9:00am** each day.

TUITION PAYMENTS: This is reminder that tuition is due on Wednesday of each week for the next weeks tuition. Tuition payments are debited from your checking account or debit/credit card. **EACH FAMILY MUST HAVE A VALID CHECKING ACCOUNT OR DEBIT/CREDIT CARD ACCOUNT ON FILE VIA THE TUITION EXPRESS AUTHORIZATION.** If your tuition payment is returned due to insufficient funds, your child/children **WILL NOT** be accepted into care on Monday until the full balance has been paid in full. If you **KNOW** that there will be an issue with your draft, you need to email academy@lovencherish.org **NO LATER THAN Tuesday at 6:00pm.** No verbal communications will be accepted.

FUNDRAISING: As with most schools, fall is the busiest fundraising season. Your tuition covers the basic costs of the Level A+ care and education your child receives daily, however much more is needed. Our fundraising efforts supports all of our extracurricular activities, classroom supplies, and most importantly our students playground.

We thank all parents/guardians who supported us in our Attractions Dining Guide Fundraiser at the beginning of our school year. Our goal was \$5000.00. We profited \$150.00. Our next fundraising effort will be a Popcorn sale. Parents/Guardians, please, please, please participate in this fundraiser. We are asking that each child sell at least 15 units. There will be incentives for the child that sells the most and the classroom that sells the most units.



HARVEST THANKSGIVING MEAL: This fundraiser is one our biggest fundraisers of the year! Love N Cherish Academy along with our founding organization (Love N Cherish Family Center, Inc.) prepare a full homemade Thanksgiving meal. FALL FESTIVAL: LOVE N CHERISH ACADEMY WILL NOT HAVE A FALL FESTIVAL THIS YEAR. Instead, we are planning to have a spring fundraising festival.

APPROPRIATE CLOTHING: Although our temperatures are not reflecting it, we have entered the fall season. Please make sure that when the temperatures start to change that you have clothing at school for your child that is appropriate for the

weather. It is a SC Department of Social Service Child Care Licensing Regulation 114-506 (8) that "All children shall be given the opportunity for outdoor play daily, weather permitting." We will not go outside in the rain or when temperatures are outside of the recommended ranges according to the Child Care Weather Watch.



SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AFTER A FEVER: Keep your child home for a fever of 101 degrees or higher by mouth or 100 degrees or higher if taken under the arm. Your child can return to school or childcare with a parent note when the fever is gone for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications. Please note: An infant 4 months of age or younger with a fever (100.4 F) should receive medical attention.
